Finalists will be interviewed by a selection committee that will choose Pennsylvania's representatives to the conference. Interviews will either be in person or by phone during PA 4-H Achievement Days, most likely during the afternoon of August 6. <u>Nominees must be at least 15 years old but must not have reached their 19th birthday as of September 28.</u> National guidelines suggest students be enrolled in grades 10-12.
