Mor-Dale Farms is a dairy and crops farm owned by Ralph and Crystal Moyer in northwestern Berks county Pa.

We built a new free stall barn with 4 Lely Robotic milking units that we moved into in Jan. 2010. Capable of milking 220 – 240 cows, we are currently not at capacity. Dry cows and heifers are housed in free stall, mono slope, bedded pack barns or pasture. All feed is stored in upright silos and fed as a TMR.

We farm 450 acres growing corn, alfalfa, rye (double cropped with corn) and pasture.

All manure is processed through a methane digester generating electric, heat and then separated for bedding in all free stall barns.

We conduct school and other educational tours and would like to expand this as part of our "giving back to the community" and an important part of our business.

We are looking for ambitious, enthusiastic person's or couple who are looking for the opportunity to work on and manage a modern state of the art dairy farm. Our goal is to continue improving a sustainable dairy farm and to provide opportunity of ownership to the right person or persons.

One person's main responsibility would a herd person over seeing care of all ages of livestock.

We feel it is important for all of us to work as a team and be cross trained in some areas to allow time off and to fill in seasonally as necessary.
