- 1895 – First resident short course in Poultry Husbandry
- 1907 – First Poultry Husbandry course offered for resident credit
- 1916 – Poultry Extension Department established
- 1920 – Poultry Husbandry Department established
- 1963 – Poultry Husbandry Department name changed to Poultry Science
- 1966 – Extension Program incorporated into the Poultry Science Department
- 1994 – Poultry Education and Research Center dedicated
